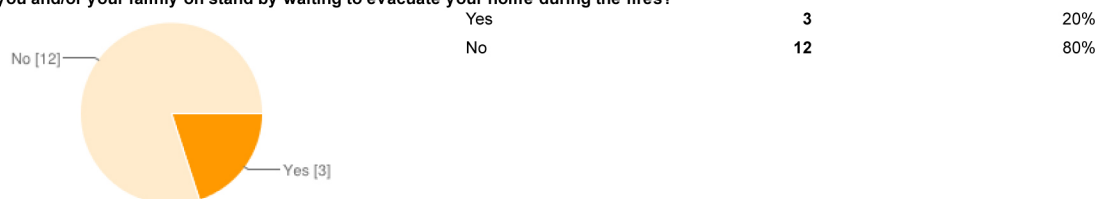

1. How were you informed to evacuate?



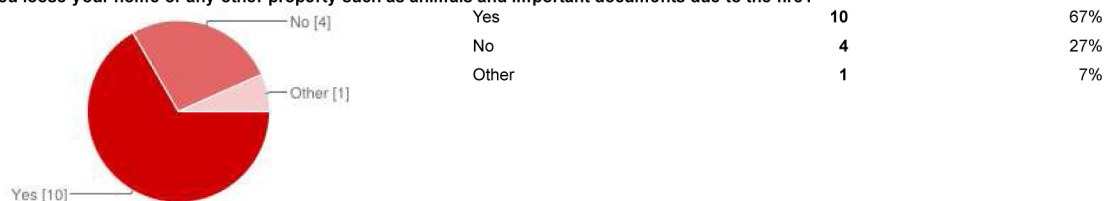
2. Were you and/or your family on stand by waiting to evacuate your home during the fires?



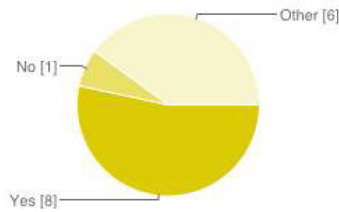
If you answered "Yes" to the previous question, please explain how this effected you and/or your family:

3. Did you loose your home or any other property such as animals and important documents due to the fire?

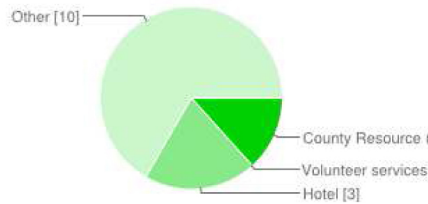

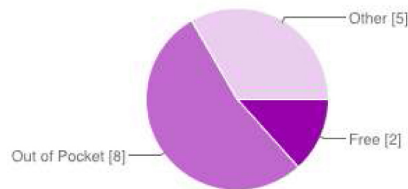

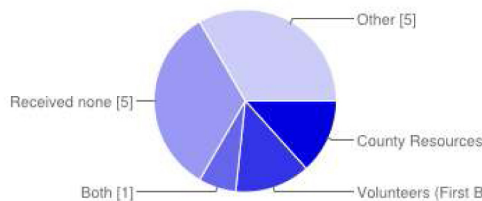

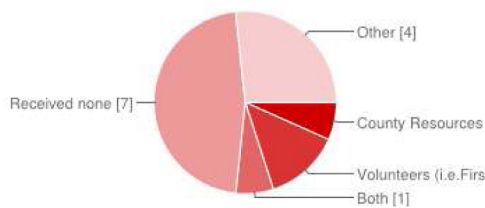

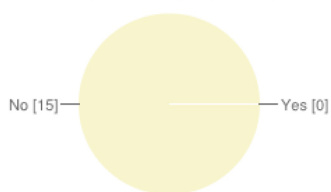

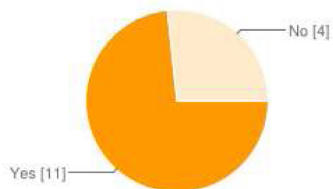
